

Ultimate Texas Hold'em Poker

This game leaves you plenty of wagering freedom, but it is at the same time full of excitement and fun.

Some examples:

- The **sooner** you bet, the more you can bet.
- You do not have to fold until you have seen all the community cards.
- There is an optional **extra bet** called TRIPS (you win, if your final 5-card hand is three-of-a-kind or higher).

You play this game against the croupier, so don't bother with the other players' hands.

How to start?

Place two equal bets where it says ante and blind. You can also place a bet on trips, if you wish. Each of the players, as well as the croupier will be dealt two cards face down.

You can make a high or a low bet ... or no bet at all!

1. When you are dealt **your two cards**, you can choose to **do nothing** (check) or **make a bet** (play), which must be 3 or 4 times the amount of your initial bet (ante).
2. Then the croupier will deal the first **three community cards** (flop), which will be face up. If up to this point you still haven't made a bet (play), you can again opt to **do nothing** (check) or **make a bet** (play), which this time must be 2 times the amount of your initial bet (ante).
3. At this point the croupier will deal the last **two community cards**, which will be face up. If you still haven't made a bet (play), you can decide to **fold or bet** (play) the same amount as your initial (ante) bet.
4. Now the croupier will show his two face down cards and announce his best 5-card hand from the 7 cards that have been dealt.

Who wins?

The below chart shows different possible outcomes depending on your hand and the croupier's. It is very important if the croupier's hand is good enough for him to open. In fact he needs a pair or a better hand to "open".

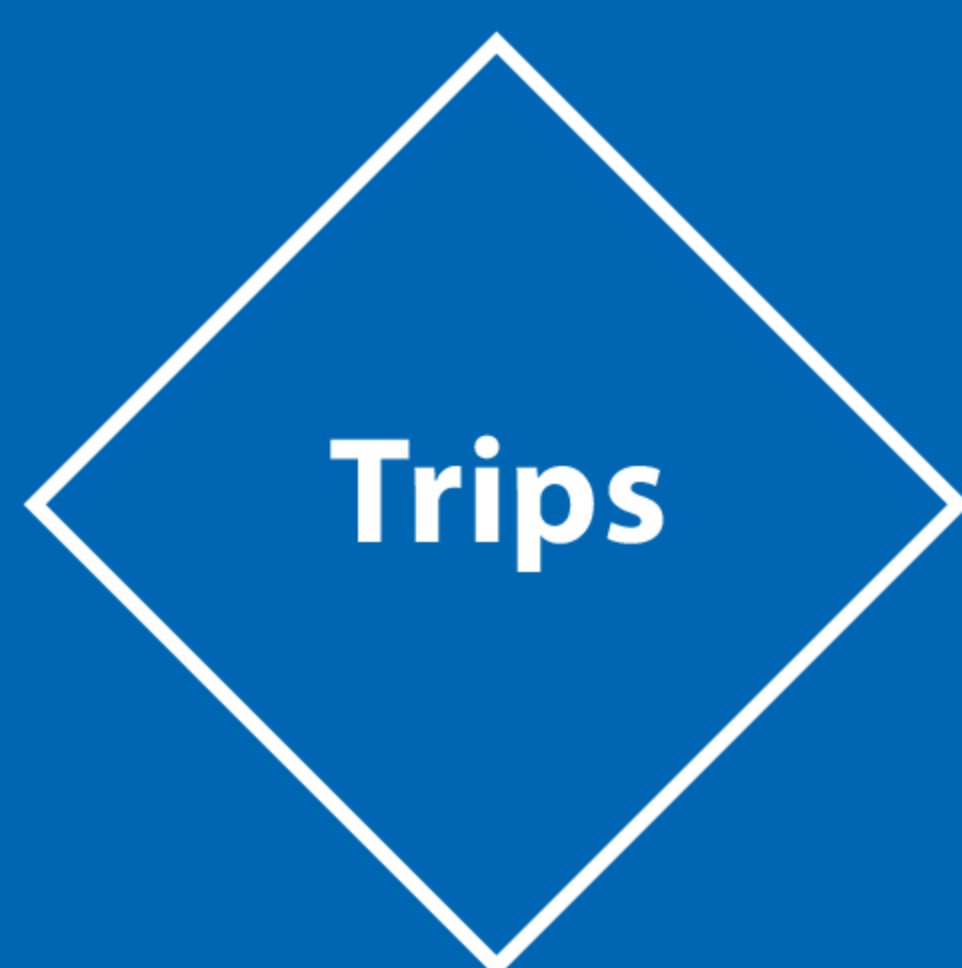
